*School Improvement Services (SI)*

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| SI01 - School Improvement Services (Curr. & Instr.) | SIS provides curriculum & instruction support for educators (in your district and via workshops) and related professional networking groups; led by Heather Fish. |
| SI02 - Curriculum Specialist                        | Additional trainer/consultant time in your district to support your district's initiatives.   |
| SI03 - PI-34 Consortium                             | Support for all educators in the creation, completion, and approval of educator licensing requirements.   |

| SP02 - Audiologist                                    | Services provided as required in a district's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for students for students with hearing needs.  |
| SP03 - Audiology Access                               | District staff can consult with an audiologist and receive discounted rates for audiologist service.   |
| SP04 - Autism Support Specialist                      | Provides coaching to your staff concerning specific students and overall strategies for serving students with Autism.  |
| SP05 - Classroom for the Cognitively Disabled         | Services provided as required in a district's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for students with significant disabilities.  |
| SP06 - Early Childhood Classroom                      | Services provided as required in a district's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for students.  |
| SP07 - Educational Interpreter                        | Services provided as required in a district's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for students with hearing needs.   |
| SP08 - Classroom for the Deaf & Hard of Hearing       | Services provided as required in a district's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for students.  |
| SP09 - Teacher for the Deaf & Hard of Hearing - Itin. | Services provided as required in a district's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for students.  |
| SP10 - Occupational Therapy                           | Services provided as required in a district's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for students.  |
| SP11 - Orientation & Mobility                         | Services provided as required in a district's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for students with vision needs.  |
| SP12 - Physical Therapy                               | Services provided as required in a district's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for students.  |
| SP13 - School Psychology Services                     | Addressing the needs of at-risk students and of students with disabilities through the special education assessment, eligibility, and placement process; along with system level behavior and mental health support. |
